ORDINANCE NO. 328 OF 2017

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 15 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, BOROUGH OF NORTH APOLLO, CHAPTER 15 MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC ESTABLISHING ADDITIONAL STOP SIGN INTERSECTIONS

WHEREAS, the Borough of North Apollo has enacted Section 213(1) which established stop sign intersections located within the Borough;

WHEREAS, the Borough of North Apollo believes it is in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of North Apollo Borough to enact an ordinance establishing additional stop signs for the purpose of controlling traffic within the Borough of North Apollo;

WHEREAS, the Borough of North Apollo believes that the establishment of the additional stop signs will control traffic and avoid injury to innocent citizens and visitors within the Borough;

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained and enacted by the Council of North Apollo Borough:

SECTION I – STOP INTERSECTIONS ESTABLISHED

1. Chapter 15, Section 213(1) of the Code of Ordinances, Borough of North Apollo, Stop Sign Intersections Established is amended to add the following stop streets, intersections or through streets, in direction of travel:

Direction of Travel

Nineteenth Street

Acheson Street

East and West

Twentieth Street

Moore Avenue

East and West

Thirteenth Street

Robbins Avenue

East and West

Fourteenth Street

Cochran Avenue

North and South

Fourteenth Street

Leonard Avenue

North and South

SEVERABILITY

Any parts or portion of any prior ordinance conflicting with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon enactment and shall remain in full force and effect thereafter until amended by further action of the Council of North Apollo Borough.
