**ORDINANCE NO. 349 of 2023**

**AN ORDINANCE OF NORTH APOLLO BOROUGH AMENDING CHAPTER 15 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF NORTH APOLLO BOROUGH TO ESTABLISH AN ADDITIONAL STOP SIGN INTERSECTION**

**WHEREAS**, the Borough of North Apollo (the “Borough”) has enacted Section 213(1), which established stop sign intersections within the Borough; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough has determined that it is in the best interest of the public health, safety, and welfare of the Borough to enact an ordinance establishing an additional stop sign intersection within the Borough to control traffic and avoid injury to person and property;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED AND ENACTED** that Chapter 15, Section 213(1) of the Code of Ordinances of North Apollo Borough is amended as follows:

**STOP SIGN INTERSECTION ESTABLISHED**

1. Chapter 15, Section 213(1) is amended to add the following stop sign street(s) and intersection(s) in the indicated direction(s) of travel:

<u>Street</u>	<u>Intersection/Through Street</u>	<u>Direction</u>
Leonard Avenue	13 <sup>th</sup> Street	Both directions.
13 <sup>th</sup> Street	Leonard Avenue	Both directions.

**REPEALER AND SEVERABILITY**

Any parts of any prior ordinance conflicting with this ordinance are hereby repealed. Chapter 15, Section 213(1) shall only be amended as expressly set forth herein and shall otherwise remain in full force and effect. Should any provision of these ordinances be determined invalid, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

**EFFECTIVE DATE**

Ordinance 349 of 2023 shall take effect immediately upon enactment and shall remain in full force and effect until amended by further action by the Council of North Apollo Borough.

This Ordinance being ordained and enacted at a public meeting this 7<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2023, a quorum being present.
